

VERSA-GLIDES & TRACTION MAT KIT

PLEASE NOTE: When installing your glides, lay all pieces on your trailer and let sit for at least 30 minutes to become climatized before attaching with screws.

Versa-Glide Installation Instructions for tilt trailers (with straight front):

1. Place first glide against side rail of trailer and flush with front of trailer. Fasten front end of glide *tightly* with screws at the *front* of clongated holes.

This kit includes:

8 - 5' ski tracks (glides)

4 - 61/2" x 6' high-density rubber traction mats

96 - Stainless steet screws

Tools needed:

Large Phillips screwdriver -or-

Drill with Phillips head

- 2. Fasten screws in the *center* of each of the other elongated holes *loosely*. *DO NOT TIGHTEN*. (Leaving these screws loose will allow the glide to slide and remain flat when it expands and contracts with temperature changes.)
- 3. Place rear glide against side rail of trailer, leaving a minimum of a 1" gap between the front and rear glides. (Leave a minimum 1/2" gap if installed during the summer months). Fasten back end of glide *tight-ly* with screws at the *back* of the elongated holes.
- 4. Fasten the additional screws loosely in the center of the remaining holes, as noted in step two.
- 5. Measure the distance between the wear-rods on your sled. Install the next glide at the front of the trailer as in step one, using this measurement as the distance between the *center* of the outside front glide to the *center* of the inside glide.
- 6. Install the rear glide as in step three.
- 7. Repeat steps for other side of the trailer.

Versa-Glide Installation Instructions for trailers (with V-front):

1. Follow directions above to install glides on the body of the trailer. If you wish to continue the glides onto the V-front portion of the deck, additional glide sections can be purchased individually. Position the glides in-line with the glides already installed, leaving a minimum 1" gap (or 1/2" if installed during the summer months.)

Traction Mat Installation Instructions:

1. Place traction mats flush with back of trailer, centered between glides. Fasten 1" from edges and corners with 8 screws spaced evenly. Be careful not to screw into aluminum crossmembers, or other metal parts of the trailer.
